MINIMUM CRITERIA:

- MUST BE A US CITIZEN
- MUST HAVE A PLAN IN PLACE, PURSUING A CAREER AS A LICENSED ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELOR (LADC)
- MUST BE ENROLLED IN AN ACCREDITED PROGRAM IN NEBRASKA
- IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS IN RECOVERY FROM ALCOHOL/DRUG ADDICTION, THEY MUST HAVE MAINTAINED AT LEAST TWO CONTINUOUS YEARS OF RECOVERY
